**INVITATION TO THE
5TH OPEN INTERNATIONAL
GERMAN CHAMPIONSHIP F3N MOD. 2007
AUGUST 31 TO SEPTEMBER 02, 2007 AT MUNICH.**

1. ORGANIZER

The German championship class F3N mod. for the year 2007 is to be held on August 31 to September 02, 2007 with competition number 68/2007 of the German aero club – section modellflug.

The organisation of this competition is assigned to the Munich-Heli-Team. (www.munich-heli-team.de)

2. AIM, TITLE, PRICES

The aim of this competition is the comparison in the sport of remote controlled flight with model helicopters, in particular the determination of the German champion.

For the open international German championship the title of a "German champion" as well as the 2nd and 3rd place winner will be awarded, also medals in gold, silver and bronze and diplomas of the DAeC.

3. CONTEST RULES

The contest will be run according to the modified regulations for model sport (BeMod), 43-54, Annex 5F

The program has been modified as follows:

5F.2.b Gyros: All stabilization systems are permitted, that do not allow pre-programmed flight maneuvers.

5F.10 Compulsory: During the compulsory manoeuvres "autorotations" the engine must be off. It may be started again in order to continue the flight, with the flight time running.

The changed descriptions of the compulsory maneuvers (annex B) is added (F3N_manoeuvres_2007.pdf).

Depending on the time schedule and deviating from the BeMod KZF 43-54/5F.8 there will be 1 or 2 compulsory, 1 freestyle and 1 music freestyle round as preliminary rounds. The preliminary standings are determined by adding the normalized scores of these rounds and dropping the lowest.

The top 10 then compete in two final rounds, 1 compulsory and 1 music freestyle round. The results of these two rounds and the normalized score of the preliminary rounds are added while dropping the lowest and the result is the final score.

4. PARTICIPATION

Participation at the open international German championship is unrestricted except the following terms:

- a) payment of the entry fee by the determined date.
- b) proof of a valid liability insurance.
- c) with his registration the participant unconditionally accepts the rules and regulations of the DAeC and the Model Aircraft Sports Group as well as the anti-doping regulations.
- d) a maximum of 40 competitors can be accepted in the order of the payment of the entry fee.

5. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for the German championship F3N mod. is € 30,-.
